Environmental Policy

Bahía del Duque opened its doors in 1993 with the intention of being a benchmark in the luxury tourism sector. Located in Adeje, this ambitious project is the culmination of an idea that arose with the intention of diversifying the tourism offer in the Canary Islands and creating skilled jobs.

From the outset, at Bahía del Duque we have made it a priority to improve our environmental performance, carry out activity in an environmentally-friendly way and try to minimise the impact on the environment. Our commitment to the environment is demonstrated by having obtained different international awards from within and outside the sector.

In our desire to improve, and really bearing in mind the principles of sustainable development, we have decided to take another step forward by implementing an Environmental Management System in our accommodation and restaurant hospitality services in accordance with the ISO 14001:2015 standard and the EMAS European Regulation. We thus commit to fulfilling all its requirements by having the necessary human, technical and economic resources to continuously maintain and improve it, with the leadership of the General Management.

Consequently, we have developed this Environmental Policy by establishing the following commitments:

- Fulfil the legal and regulatory requirements within the scope of the implementation of activity, and in all those that we voluntarily sign.
- Promote environmental protection, preventing pollution and implementing saving and efficiency strategies in the consumption of natural resources and raw materials, as well as prevention and reduction in generating emissions, discharges and waste produced by activity.
- Promote and facilitate appropriate environmental competency, training and awareness for all staff, encouraging their active participation and motivation as a key factor for the attainment of environmental challenges and objectives.
- Choose suppliers who are committed to the environment, promoting compliance with sustainability criteria in our purchases and contracting of services.
- Make our Environmental Policy and Statement public, inviting our stakeholders to participate in the commitments we acquire.

Based on this declaration of principles that we periodically review and update, we implement objectives that enable us to continuously improve our environmental behaviour, positioning ourselves as an environmentally-friendly tourist company and respectful towards future generations.
